Admission to **Nursery** is based on simple activities relating to various areas of learning and growth, through which we assess the physical, mental and emotional readiness of the child for attending school at the nursery level.

We also look for evidence of basic values and good manners.

Admission to Nursery will be based on the following areas:

- Physical & Mental Readiness for Nursery
- General Awareness
- Gross Motor Skills
- Nascent social skills (ability to play / share with others; greeting; introducing oneself)
- Confidence & Communication Skills (any language preferably English)
- Curiosity & inquisitiveness
- Basic Intelligence & Retention
- Evidence of basic values and good manners
- Body Parts Recognition
- Ability to Recite (Hindi / English) Poem
- Recognition of colours
- General Conversational Skills
- Recognition of letters A Z
- Counting 1 − 20
- Recognition of अ अः

ENGLISH / COMMUNICATION SKILLS (IN ANY LANGUAGE) GUIDELINES

The interaction will focus on the ability of the student to:-

A. LISTEN (ANY 1 OF THE FOLLOWING ABILITIES)

- 1. Understand simple language structures such as instructions given by teachers
- 2. Understand greetings and compliments
- 3. Listen to and understand simple conversation

B. SPEAK (ANY 1 OF THE FOLLOWING ABILITIES)

- 1. Recite simple poems and rhymes
- 2. Greet and make polite requests
- 3. Name / Describe feelings, likes, dislikes, etc.

C. DISPLAY PRE-READING SKILLS (ANY 1 OF THE FOLLOWING ABILITIES)

- 1. Identify patterns and letter formation
- 2. Use pictures and visual clues to understand a story

D. DISPLAY PRE-WRITING SKILLS (ANY 1 OF THE FOLLOWING ABILITIES)

- 1. Display small muscle skills through weaving, colouring, cutting, pasting, keyboarding, putting things in boxes and bottles, stringing beads, etc.
- 2. Make purposeful marks and letters
