In this regard kindly acknowledge the following instructions for **Participating as well as Non Participating students**.

### NON - PARTICIPATING STUDENTS (NURSERY – XI)

The school shall be declared holiday for non-participating students on account of intense practice w. e. f. **5.11.2016 to 11.11.16** (Saturday to Friday)

- All parents along with their children are cordially invited on **12.11.16** (Saturday) to grace the occasion.

### PARTICIPATING STUDENTS (NURSERY –VI)

The participating students of classes Nursery – VI shall report at DPS Aligarh (Senior Wing) for rehearsals and depart from the school as mentioned in the practice schedule attached w. e. f. **05.11.16 to 08.11.16** (Saturday to Tuesday) and from 10.11.16 to 12.11.16 (Thursday – Saturday).

- The students shall be given food packets on **10.11.16, 11.11. 16 & 12.11.16**. However parents are suggested to send an extra lunch pack / water bottle etc.

### PARTICIPATING STUDENTS (VII – XI)

- The participating students of classes VII to XI shall report to DPS Aligarh (Senior Wing) for rehearsals and depart from the school as mentioned in the practice schedule w. e. f. **05.11.16 to 08.11.16** (Saturday to Tuesday).
- The participating students of classes VII to XI shall report to Senior Wing with their baggage for three days to stay in the school premises from **10.11.2016 to 12.11.16** (Thursday – Saturday). The students shall depart on **13.11.16 (Sunday)** at 10:00am after breakfast.
- High Standard vegetarian and hygienic food will be served during the stay; hence, **strictly no eatables from home or outside are allowed** inside the school campus. The accommodation, fooding and lodging facilities of students shall be well taken care of.
- The boys (class VII – XI) shall be accommodated in the Senior Wing School along with the teachers.
- The girls (class VII – XI) shall be accommodated in the premises of the Mangalayatan Campus adjacent to DPS Senior Wing along with lady teachers.

- Students from class VII onwards who are coming for 3 days stay are required to come on **10.11.2016** (Thursday) with their baggage which should include the following :-
  - a) Three to four sets of casual wear
  - b) Night Dress, bath towel, toiletries etc.
  - c) Sport shoes and a pair of bathroom slippers
  - d) Water bottle, I-card and a cap
- Proper sleeping arrangements will be made, however a light single blanket may be carried (OPTIONAL).
- Facilities for the basic medical aid will be available. But those on special medication are advised to bring their medicines.
- Parents who wish to meet their wards on 10 and 11 November are allowed to meet them between 12 noon and 2:00 p.m.
