ENGLISH

1. Travel Journal: Write a 5-7 day travel journal describing experiences, sights, food, and feelings while visiting a place like The Himalayas, a beach town (like Goa), or a historical city (like Delhi, Agra, Jaipur, etc) during your holidays. Sketch or paste 2–3 visuals (like a monument, a local dish, or traditional dress).

2. Book Review: Read a book and write a 150-200 word review covering main characters, plot summary, likes/dislikes, and moral/message learned.

3. Grammar Detective: Identify and list 5 nouns, 5 adjectives, 5 prepositions, 5 conjunctions, and 3 tenses used from a storybook or English textbook. Create sentences using each.

4. Speech Writing: Write a speech on "My Role in Building a Better World."

HINDI

Rational Numbers

1. Recipe Book: Create a recipe book with fractions and decimals used in cooking. Calculate ingredient quantities for 8, 15 and 80 serving sizes.

2. Measurement Project: Measure and calculate the area and perimeter of different rooms or objects in your home using rational numbers.

Linear Equations in one Variable

1. Personal Budget: Create a personal budget plan using linear equations to track income and expenses.

2. Science Exploration: Research and create a project on how linear equations are used in a scientific field (e.g., Physics, Chemistry, Biology).

Project

1. Shopping Trip: Plan a shopping trip with a budget constraint. Use rational numbers to calculate costs and linear equations to stay within budget.

SCIENCE

Eco-Warrior Scrapbook

Create a scrapbook on "How I Can Help the Environment"

• Include photos, newspaper clippings, and your own ideas for reducing plastic use, saving water, and planting trees. Meet a Scientist

- Research a famous scientist (e.g., Marie Curie, A.P.J. Abdul Kalam. Elbert Einstein. Thomas Edison etc).
- Prepare a short biography with their key contributions.
- Include pictures and a creative timeline. (in scrap book)

1. Design a Bridge: Create a model of a bridge using everyday materials, considering the forces acting on it (tension, compression, gravity).

2. Inventions: Design an invention that utilizes forces (e.g., a catapult, a pulley system).

1. Forces in Sports: Create a power point presentation showcasing how forces are used in various sports (e.g., football, basketball, tennis).

3. FORCE-THEMED ART:

1. Create artwork inspired by forces, using different mediums (e.g., painting, drawing, sculpture).
